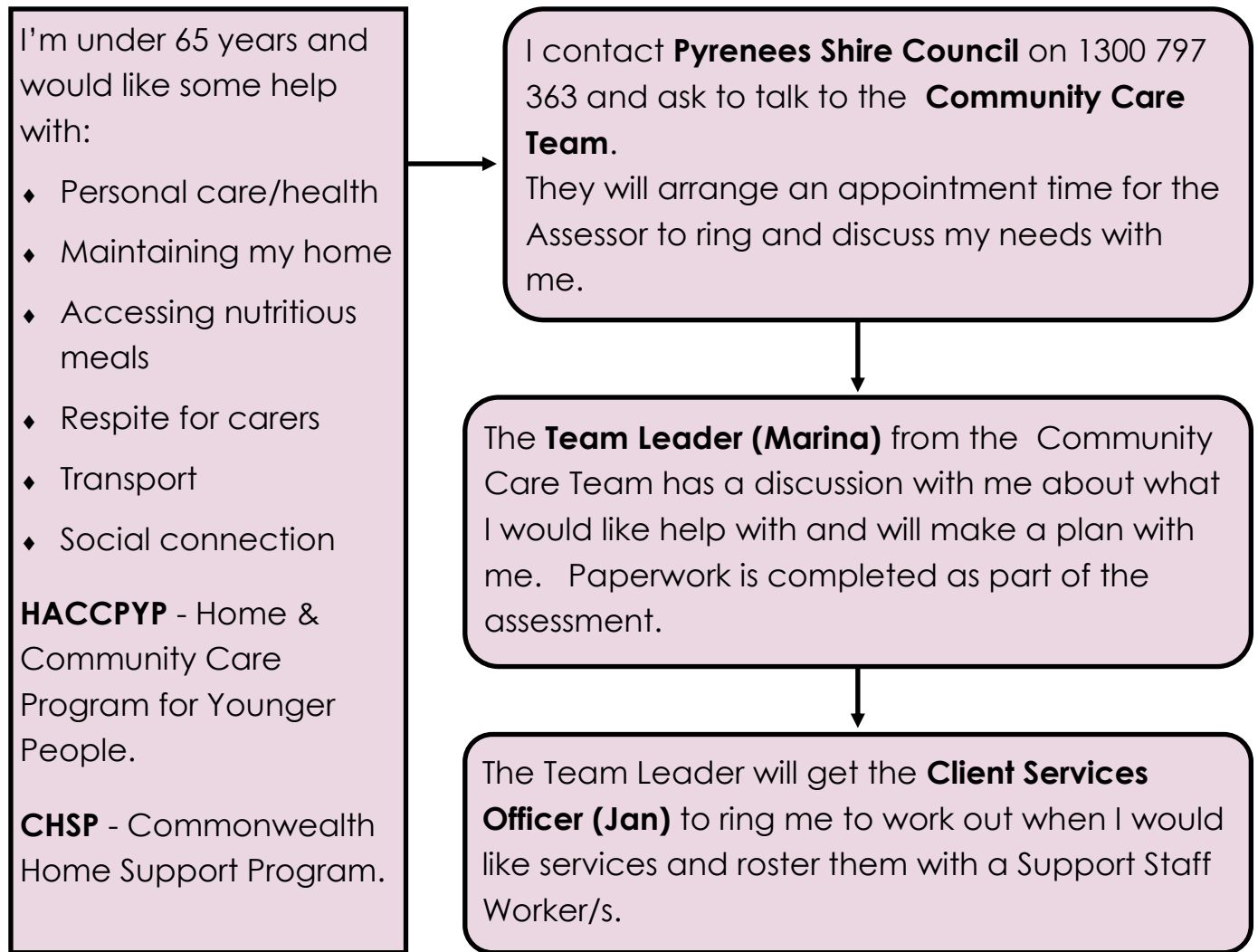

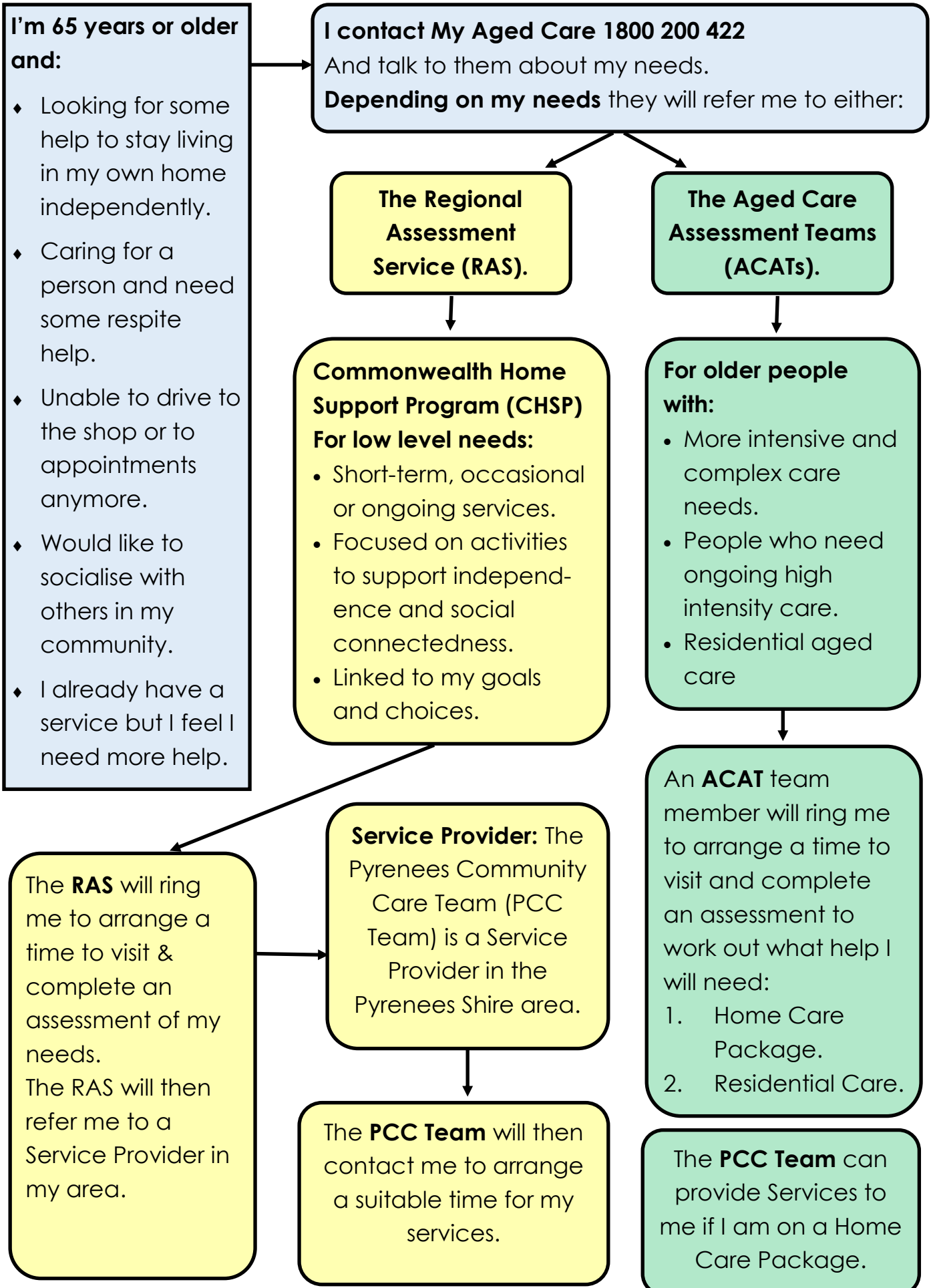

25th December 2020 to 1st January 2021 - Christmas / New Year Office Closure (dates to be confirmed).

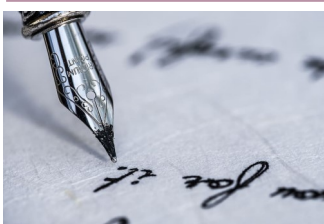
AND NOW FOR SOMETHING DIFFERENT...
