 - * Penalty for a dog that rushes at, attacks, worries or chases any person or animal - up to 120 Penalty Units
 - * Penalty for a dog or cat causing a nuisance - up to 3 Penalty Units
 - * Penalty for a dog or cat failing to wear a Registration Tag - up to 2 Penalty Units

* *Approved training documentation is required at the time of registration. If the cat/dog is registered with an applicable organisation, the owner must also hold a membership for that association and documentation must be provided at the time of registration, and as requested annually.*

STATE GOVERNMENT LEVY

The above fees include a State Government Levy of \$4.10 for dog registrations and \$4.10 for cat registrations. This levy is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership programs.

COMPULSORY DESEXING OF CATS

If you own a cat in Pyrenees Shire it must be desexed. Council is unable to register a cat unless it is desexed. Exemptions will only be made for cats covered by the *Domestic Animals Act 1994* Section 10B. Desexing your cat will help reduce the number of stray and unwanted cats in Pyrenees Shire.

COMPULSORY MICROCHIPPING

Council is unable to register a dog or cat that has not been implanted with a microchip. This includes previously registered dogs and cats that move into the Pyrenees Shire Council from another Council. Proof of microchipping must be supplied.

MICROCHIPPING

An owner will no longer be entitled to a reduced fee for their animal being microchipped alone. Proof of microchipping is required when registering your animal.

ADDITIONAL ANIMALS

To keep more than 2 dogs or 2 cats, you will be require a permit. To apply, please contact Council on 1300 797 363.

CONCESSION

If you wish to claim a concession you must supply proof of your Centrelink or Department of Veterans Affairs Pensioner Concession card. **Health Care cards are not accepted.**

LIFETIME REGISTRATION TAGS

Lost or destroyed tags can be replaced upon written application and the payment of \$3.00 per tag.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

In person: Please bring your completed registration application, microchip and/or desexing certificate and Concession Card (if eligible) to Pyrenees Shire Council Offices at 5 Lawrence Street, Beaufort.

Mail: Please complete the registration application and provide a copy of your microchip certificate and/or desexing certificate and concession card (if eligible) and mail to Pyrenees Shire Council, 5 Lawrence Street, BEAUFORT VIC 3373. Payment options are: Cheque or Money Order. If you wish to pay by Australia Post, BPAY or Credit Card, an invoice will be issued with 28 days to pay.
