# **Infringement Payment Plan and Extension of Time Information**

## What is a Payment Plan?

A Payment Plan is an agreement between council and a community member which enables an Infringement to be paid off in instalments at regular monthly intervals over a period of six (6) months. Council may make exceptions to allow payment plans to take place for a period longer than six (6) months on a case-by-case basis.

### **Payment Plans**

- Are offered to persons automatically entitled as per the Infringements Act 2006 (Vic);
- Discretionary requests (i.e requests from applicants that do not meet the relevant concession card requirements, however are experiencing exceptional circumstances or financial hardship);
- Must meet a minimum monthly payment of \$20 per infringement (concession card applicants) or \$40 per infringement (non-concession card applicants); and
- Are offered for infringements over \$100 only.

#### What is an Extension of Time?

An Extension of Time is an agreement between Council and a community member which provides the community member with up to an additional 6 months after the initial Infringement due date or the Infringement Penalty Reminder Notice due date to pay the Infringement in full. Council may make exceptions to allow payment plans to take place for a period longer than six (6) months on a case-by-case basis.

#### **Extensions of Time**

- Are offered to persons automatically entitled as per the *Infringements Act 2006* (Vic);
- Discretionary requests (i.e requests from applicants that do not meet the relevant concession card requirements, however are experiencing exceptional circumstances or financial hardship).

## Who is eligible for a Payment Plan or an Extension of Time?

Under the *Infringements Act 2006* (Vic) a person is eligible for a Payment Plan or an Extension of Time where they hold one of the following:

- a Commonwealth Government (Centrelink) Pensioner Concession Card;
- a Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card or Gold Card; or
- a Centrelink Health Care Card.

Holders of Victorian Seniors Card or Commonwealth Government Seniors Card are not automatically entitled to access a payment plan. However, agencies may at their discretion offer these card holders access to a payment plan.

## **Discretionary Requests - Financial Hardship or Exceptional Circumstances**

If the applicant does not hold one of the above eligible cards, they may still apply on the basis of exceptional circumstances or financial hardship. They must provide a written explanation outlining their exceptional circumstances or financial hardship and attach any relevant information or supporting documents.

Council will take many factors into account when assessing your application. Factors contributing to hardship generally include family tragedy, financial misfortune, serious illness, impacts of natural disaster and other serious or difficult circumstances. Each applicant is treated in accordance with their individual circumstances on a case- by-case basis.

## **Applications made by Companies**

Council may offer a payment plan or extension of time to a company or person applying under a company name, but these plans are not regulated by the *Infringements Act 2006* (Vic).

<u>NOTE:</u> To apply for an Extension of Time or a Payment Plan for a Parking Infringement, the applicant must be the registered owner or the nominated driver of the vehicle which incurred the Infringement Notice.
