Projects and Works



Cambridge Street Activation, Avoca

Avoca's Cambridge Street Activation project is being finalised, ready for works to happen in July and August, with funding from the Victorian Government's COVID Outdoor Activation Fund.

The western end of Cambridge Street will be transformed into a pedestrian friendly link between the Avoca River flats and the main street. With lighting, street art, shade and seating, the link will allow for new uses, including market overflow, street performances and informal picnicking. It will also provide better access to the Chinese Gardens, skate park and other recreational points.

Local traffic vehicle access will continue, with road closures for some events.

Avoca Senior Citizens Centre

A building permit for the Avoca Senior Citizens Centre has been approved and works to repair the floor will start on Friday, July 1. Repairs are expected to be completed by July 31.

Avoca Pool Carpark

A car park in front of the Avoca Pool is planned to be built. This will provide safer access to the pool. Construction will begin in the next few months and should be completed before the opening of the pool season.

Floodway reconstruction on Mills Lane, Amphitheatre

Work has started and is expected to finish in mid-July. There will be road closures with detours and signage in place. These works are weather dependent, there may be a delay if there is significant rainfall.

Avoca Pathway Repairs

Footpaths along High Street in Avoca will be repaired and replaced between July and August. Please be aware of these works and take care when walking around town.

Raglan Elmhurst Road Bridge

Works on Bridge 139 at Raglan Elmhurst Road have been postponed and will start in around six weeks. Third party phone cabling needs to be removed from the bridge before works can start.

Carngham Streatham Road Bridge

Works on Bridge 32 on Carngham Streatham Road have begun. Signage and detours are in place. Works are expected to finish around August.

Avoca Digital Hub

Work on the Avoca Digital Hub is expected to be finished in early-August. During this time, bookings for the two back rooms will be unavailable; however, other rooms will be able to be booked.

Upcoming Road Closures

Bridge 32 – Carngham Streatham Road closed from end of June to mid-August

Bridge 139 – Raglan Elmhurst Road closed from mid-August to late-October

Bridge 11 – Beaufort Carngham Road closed from October to mid-December

Changes to COVID-19 Food Relief Program

Vaccination Updates

Council encourages everyone to be vaccinated against COVID-19, and to receive booster doses.

Some members of the community are now eligible for a winter booster dose. Winter booster doses can be given four months after the third dose.

Children between 5 and 12 years are eligible for COVID vaccinations and booster doses.
