

Latest Restrictions

There are no restrictions on the reasons to leave home but staying COVIDSafe remains important. Residents of regional Victoria must not travel to metropolitan Melbourne, City of Ballarat, City of Greater Geelong, Surf Coast Shire and Mitchell Shire, other than for permitted reasons:

- for authorised work or permitted education;
- to visit an intimate partner;
- for care and compassionate reasons, including permitted child minding;
- to access necessary goods and services provided they are from the facility that is closest to where you live;
- other limited reasons such as moving house.

While in these areas, you must comply with restrictions in place.
