### STATE GOVERNMENT LEVY

The above fees include a State Government Levy of \$4.64 for dog registrations. This levy is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership programs.

### EXTRA ANIMALS

To keep more than 2 dogs or 2 cats, you may require a permit. Please contact Council on 1300 797 363.

### COMPULSORY MICROCHIPPING

Council is unable to register a dog that has not been microchipped. This includes previously registered dogs that move into the Shire from another Council. Proof of microchipping must be supplied.

### LOST TAGS

Lost or destroyed tags can be replaced upon written application and the payment of \$5.00 per tag.

### \*CONCESSION

If you wish to claim a concession you must supply proof of your Centrelink or Department of Veterans Affairs Pensioner Concession Card. Health Care cards are not accepted. By applying for a concession you understand that:

- The Australian Government Department Human Services will disclose personal information to Pyrenees Shire Council including my name, address, concession card type and status to confirm my eligibility for relevant concession discounts.
- This consent, once signed, remains valid while I am a customer of Pyrenees Shire Council unless I withdraw it by contacting Pyrenees Shire Council or the department.
- I can gain proof of my circumstances/details from the department and provide it to Pyrenees Shire Council so my eligibility for relevant concession discounts can be determined.
- If I withdraw my consent or do not alternatively provide proof of my circumstances/details, I may not be eligible for the concession discount provided by Pyrenees Shire Council.

## BE A RESPONSIBLE PET OWNER UNDER THE *DOMESTIC ANIMALS ACT 1994*

- Penalty for failing to register a cat or dog over the age of 3 months – up to 20 Penalty Units
- Penalty for dogs wandering – up to 10 Penalty Units
- Penalty for a dog that rushes at, attacks, worries, or chases any person or animal – up to 120 Penalty Units
- Penalty for a dog or cat causing a nuisance – up to 3 Penalty Units
- Penalty for a dog or cat failing to wear a Registration Tag – up to 2 Penalty Units

**1 Penalty Unit = \$203.51 (as of July 2025)**
