Sorting waste properly makes a big impact. Recycling well and reducing waste in the first place helps keep valuable resources out of landfill.

## What CAN be put in your landfill bin?

Any non-recyclable items including cooking ware, pet droppings and kitty litter, broken glass (wrapped in newspaper), nappies and wipes, coffee pods, takeaway coffee cups and food waste.

## What CAN be put in your recycling bin?

Plastic drink bottles, shampoo bottles, laundry detergent bottles, milk bottles (rinse and remove lids; place in recycling bin separately\*), food containers, paper, newspapers, magazines and cardboard products, aluminium and metal cans, aluminium foil.

\*Plastic lids can now be placed in your recycling bin once removed from bottle.

## What CAN be put in your glass recycling bin?

Glass bottles and jars (rinse and remove lids; lids go in the yellow-topped recycling bin).

**Northern Area 1:** Barkly, Frenchmans, Landsborough, Landsborough West, Moonambel, Navarre, Redbank, Warrenmang, Wattle Creek

**Northern Area 2:** Barkly, Bung Bong, Homebush, Moonambel, Natte Yallock, Percydale, Rathscar, Rathscar West, Redbank, Tanwood, Wareek, Warrenmang

**Northern Area 3:** Amphitheatre, Chute, Crowlands, Elmhurst, Eversley, Frenchmans, Glenlofty, Glenlogie, Glenpatrick, Landsborough, Landsborough West, Lexton, Mount Lonarch, Percydale, Raglan, Shays Flat, Warrenmang

If your bin is missed, contact Council as soon as possible and leave your bin out for collection.
