
#### **Council meeting**

## **Fire Danger Period Declared**



The Country Fire Authority (CFA) has declared the start of the Fire Danger Period for the whole of the Pyrenees Shire will start on Monday 20 November. Once the Fire Danger Period starts, fire restrictions come into force. This means you cannot light a fire in the open air unless you have a permit or follow certain conditions.

## Prepare your property for fire

Dry conditions will increase fire risk this summer.

Now is the time to prepare your property and review your bushfire survival plan.

Reducing vegetation around your home will help keep you, your family, and the community safe.

This your responsibility, and failure to remove a fire hazard on your property may result in a fire hazard removal notice and fine.

Property owners receiving a fire hazard removal notice are given three weeks to complete the required works.
