### Forestry works road closures - Mt Lonarch/Berumgower State Forest area

Some roads around the Mt Lonarch/
Berumgower State Forest area will be closed
until June due to harvesting by HVP Forestry.
Most of these roads were already closed to the
general public due to the Bayindeen fires, and
are primarily used by the forestry industry with
some recreational use. These road closures
will ensure the safety of anyone who may wish
to use these roads during harvesting. The
community will notice an increase in heavy
vehicles using the Raglan-Elmhurst, Main Lead
and Amphitheatre roads. Drivers are asked to
obey traffic signage in these areas.

## **ROADWORKS AND PROJECTS**

### **Roadworks Eurambeen-Streatham Road**

Works have started on Eurambeen-Streatham Road, south of Mt William Road near Coburn Rd. Works will cause some traffic delays.

## Roadworks Trawalla Waterloo Road

Construction in underway on Trawalla Waterloo Road near Racecourse Road. Drainage works have been completed. Pavement works have started. These works will cause some delays.

### Avoca drainage maintenance

Avoca drainage upgrades are well advanced, and we expect there to be little impact on motorists, residents, and pedestrians.

### Caramuir Road, Nerring culvert works

Upgrade work on the Caramuir Road culvert is underway. Works include the extension of the existing culvert, road reinstatement, and installation of guard railing. The road will be closed during works, please follow the detour signs. We apologise for any inconvenience

## Roadworks Smythesdale-Snake Valley

Construction work is complete. Line marking to be completed when contractors are in the area.

### **Roadworks Pittong Snake Valley Road**

Works have started on Pittong Snake Valley Road near Cochrane Drive. Works include pavement upgrades and sealing of the unsealed road between Kelly Road and Cochrane Drive. Works will cause some traffic delays.
