## DROUGHT RELIEF MEASURES WELCOMED



Additional Victorian Government drought relief measures have been announced for southwest Victoria, including Pyrenees Shire.

A major feature is the Primary Producer Support Payments which will give eligible Pyrenees Shire farmers the equivalent of a 40 per cent rate reduction.

Another boost for the region is the commitment of \$15 million towards the East Grampians Rural Pipeline extension to provide water security, including for farmers in Pyrenees Shire's southwest. The extension is dependent on further Australian Government funding and will require a \$15.6 million Grampians Wimmera Mallee Water investment.

There is also a commitment to expand and upgrade Emergency Supply Water Points for stock and domestic water supply, as well as household payments of up to \$1000 for struggling families.

#### **OBPS** second survey

This survey is the second to be undertaken by Pyrenees Shire Council as part of the Old Beaufort Primary School Master Plan project.

Survey two will help us understand what a community hub at the site needs to be a vibrant community space that supports both Beaufort and the broader shire.

Responding to this survey will further inform the master plan outcome and support making key decisions on community buildings.
