



P60 OLD BEAUFORT PRIMARY SCHOOL MASTERPLAN

The old Beaufort Primary School Master Plan creation is underway, with a survey on Beaufort community facilities use.

The survey helps understand how Beaufort's community assets are currently used, confirms community group activities, and identifies groups that might not have a suitable space yet.

It also outlines the community's ambitions for both the Old Beaufort Primary School site and Beaufort's broader community assets.

The survey is run by consultant Public Realm Lab, which is developing the former primary school's master plan. The site is owned by the state government, but Pyrenees Shire Council is assisting with the master plan creation.

CURRENT ROADWORKS

Bridge works – McKinlay Street, Landsborough

A contractor has been appointed for bridge strengthening and guardrail replacement for bridge 107 on McKinlay Street, Landsborough. Works are planned to commence this financial year.

Culvert replacement on Linton-Carngham Road, Snake Valley

A major culvert is being replaced on Linton-Carngham Road just to the north of Laurence Drive, Snake Valley. This project is scheduled to begin in late May.

Floodway and road reconstruction on Lower Wimmera Road, Glenlogie

This project has faced delays due to the vegetation works in the area. Work is now set to begin at the end of April.

Homebush Road, Avoca culvert replacement works

Final works on the Homebush Road culvert may still be occurring this week but the road will be open to traffic.

Rutherford Street, Avoca

Kerb renewal and expansion is about to begin in Avoca from the High Street/Camp Street intersection up to Rutherford Street and back down High Street on Davy Street.

Redbank Streetscape

Roadworks in the Redbank Hall vicinity are planned to be undertaken in the first half of 2025 including kerb and channel, tree planting outstands, some planning and path work.

This project will improve community amenity by providing a better tree canopy and accessible pathways between community hubs.
